

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX
INCREASE FOR THE AURORA PUBLIC
LIBRARY DISTRICT
KANE, DUPAGE, KENDALL, AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for the Aurora Public Library District for 2022 (2022–2023 fiscal year) will be held on Wednesday, October 26, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. at the Library, 101 South River Street, Aurora, Illinois.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2021 were \$15,054,874.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$16,108,715. This represents a 7% increase over the previous year extension.
- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2021 were \$0.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2022 are \$0. This represents a 0% increase over the previous year extension.
- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2021 were \$15,054,874. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$16,108,715. This represents a 7% increase over the previous year extension.
