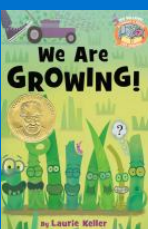


The Good for Nothing Button

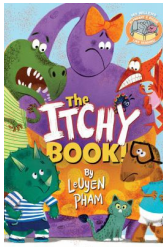


Snail's Silly Adventures
