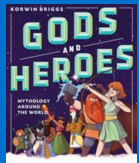

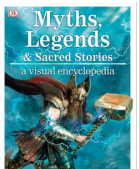

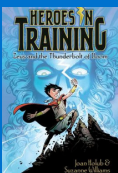

When ten-year-old Zeus is kidnapped, he discovers he can defend himself with a magical thunderbolt.

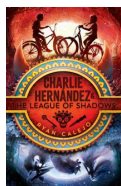

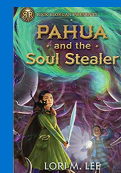
