

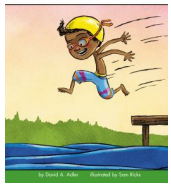

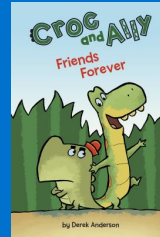

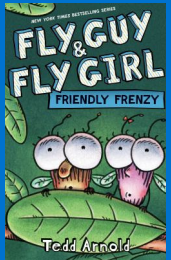


Croc and Ally: Friends Forever

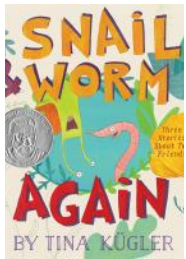
