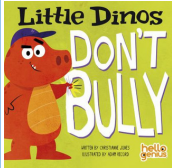

## Little Dinos Don't Bully Christianne C. Jones

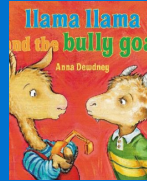
Little Dino can seem frightening to the other children, but she works hard on practicing positive behaviors, and always tries to be a friend.

## Stick and Stone Beth Ferry

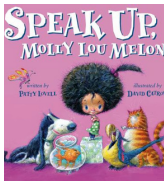
Stick and Stone are both lonely until Pinecone's teasing causes one to stick up for the other, and a solid friendship is formed.

## Speak up, Molly Lou Melon Patty Lovell

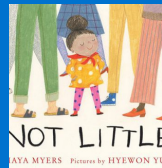

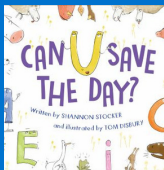
Dot proves she is not little by standing up to a school bully.

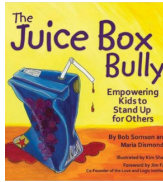
## Codzilla David Zelster

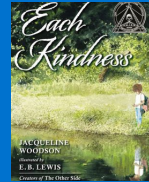

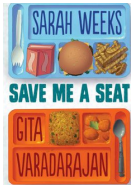
