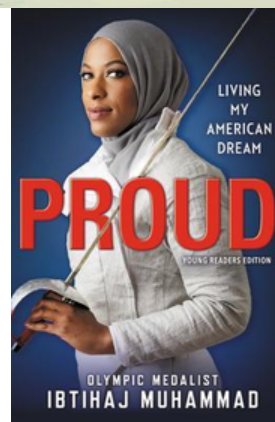

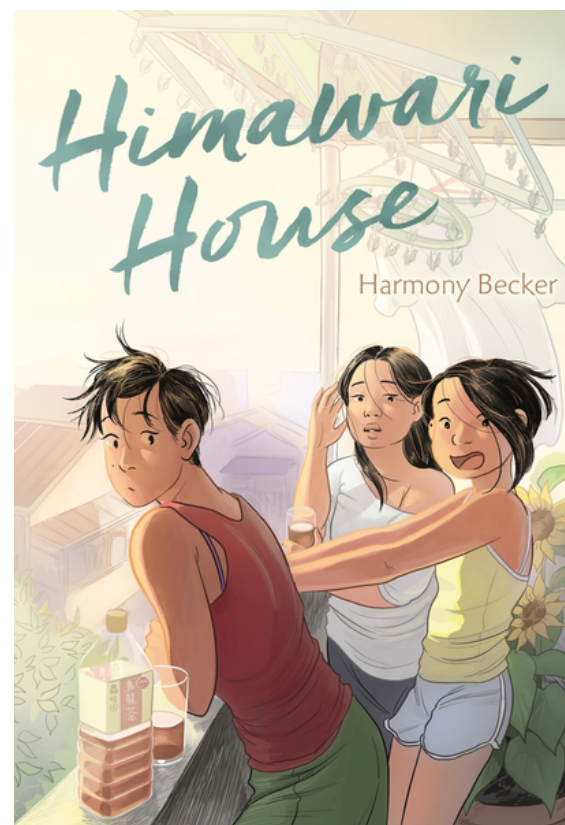

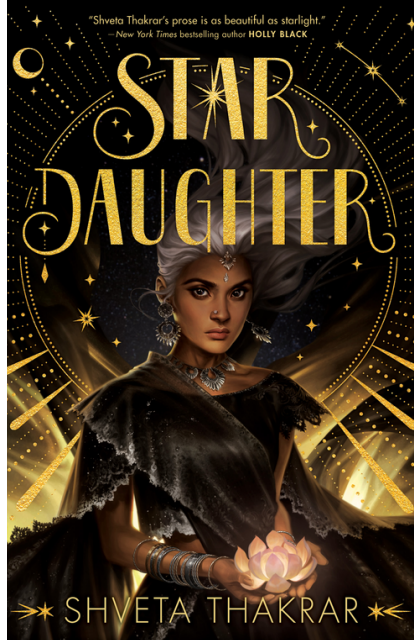


HEARTSTOPPER, VOL. 1

STAR DAUGHTER

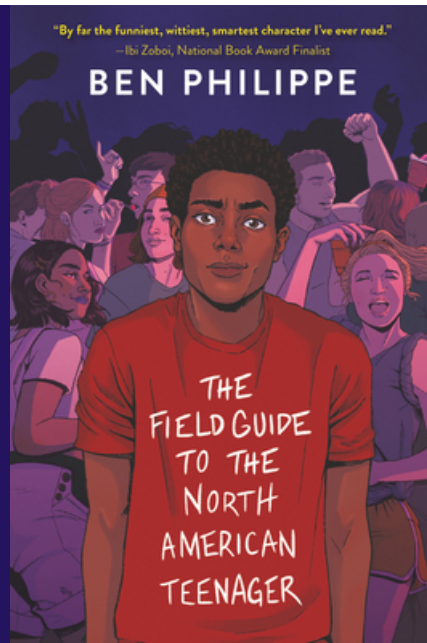
