Kids age 17 or younger who live outside City of Aurora limits but attend school in Aurora may qualify for a library card under the State of Illinois Cards for Kids Act. ## **TEACHER LOANS**

Teacher loans on a Teacher Library Card are available to schools within Aurora city limits. Email teacherloan@aurorapubliclibrary.org to submit requests of up to 50 items to be delivered to your school. Requests for specific items may be limited based on availability. Loan periods for books on school cards is 8 weeks with no renewals.
