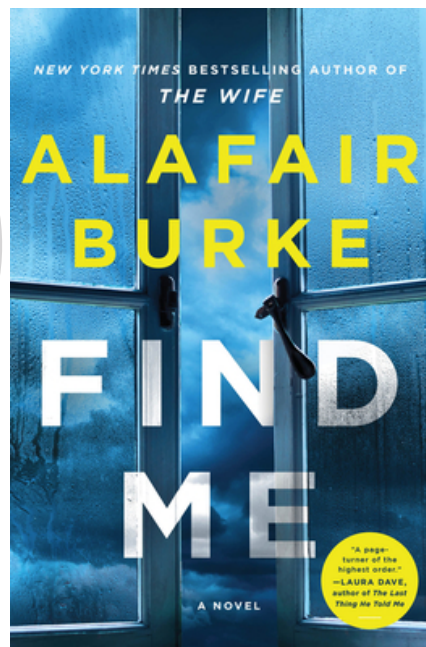




## ABANDONED IN DEATH

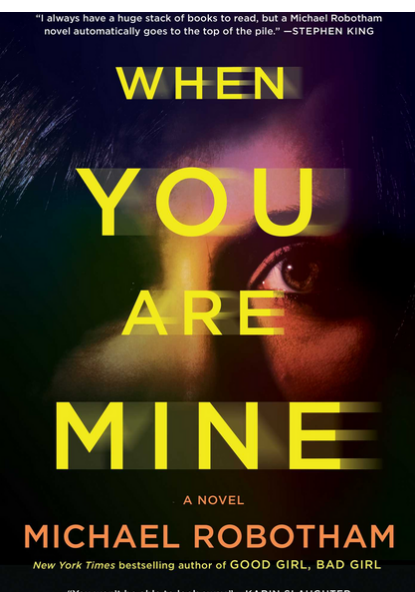
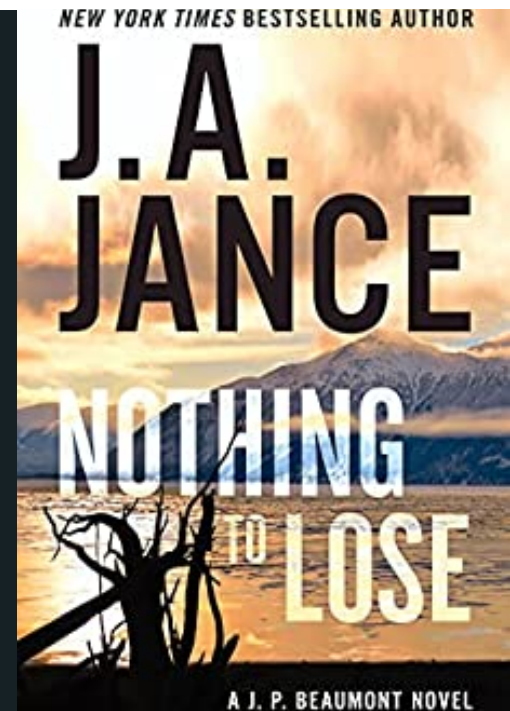
