1. Will boring be required for the electrical?

Yes, boring will be required to run power from the library building to the new sign's location.

2. Do you want a Watchfire brand display?

We did not specify a brand in the RFP; you may suggest products from any vendor.

3. Were you aware that the City changed the sign ordinance?

4. Are you tied to 16mm color LEDs for the sign definition?

The RFP specifies the minimum acceptable sign definition as 16mm color LEDs in a 36x126 matrix. Bidders are welcome to submit proposals with higher-quality definition, or to submit multiple definition options.

5. Can you provide exact specifications for the electrical work?
