

# Llama Weaving Craft

## Materials Needed:

- Yarn
- Cardstock llama
- Tape
- Markers
- Scissors

## How to Weave a Cardstock Llama:

**Step 1:** Cut out llama just outside the outline.

### Step 2:

Cut out the same number of slits on the top and bottom of your llama to hold your warp threads. Make sure they're evenly spaced. Five works well.

### Step 3:

String your vertical starter (warp) threads.

- Tape one end of a piece of yarn to the back of your llama.
- Then, go up and down around your llama until all of slits are filled with yarn. Move from left to right.
- Tape the end of your yarn to the back.

### Step 4:

Take out a piece of yarn to weave. Tie one end to your warp (top of the left string.)

Wrap the other end with masking tape (to help weave.) You could also use a yarn needle (but you don't really need one.)

### Step 5:

Go over and under each warp thread. When you reach the end of one row, do the opposite pattern of over and under for the next row. Keep alternating until you're done with your piece of yarn (or you decide to change colors.)

To add another piece of yarn, tie on your new piece of yarn to your old piece of yarn. (Trim the excess.) Then, keep on weaving!

When you're done, tie the end of your yarn to your warp.

**Step 6:** Decorate your llama with markers, sequins—whatever you like!
