

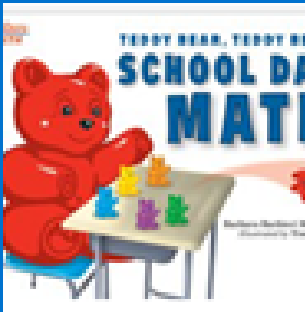

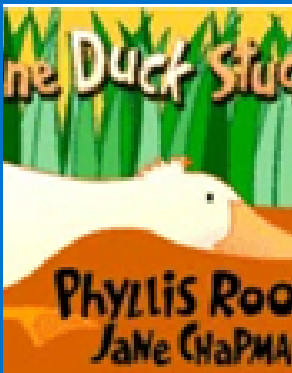

### Rhyme

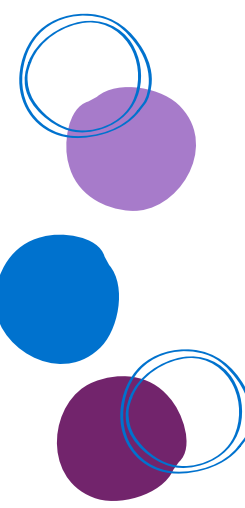
#### Ten in a Bed

## Activity

- Cut some small squares from different colored paper and let your child practice placing it on various types of lines—curved, jagged, or a letter.
- Start a pattern and encourage your child to continue it. For example, red-red-blue-green-green. Let them come up with their own patterns or challenge you to complete one.
