The Aurora Public Library is closely monitoring the ongoing coronavirus disease (COVID-19). The health and safety of our community and our staff is our top priority. At this time, there are no indications that any of our locations are affected. These safety measures are as a precaution, not due to any known exposure.

- All meetings and programs have been cancelled through April 12, 2020.
- We will be closed on Sunday, March 15, 2020.
- We will open on Monday, March 16, 2020 with limited service which include placing items on hold, picking up holds and a small browsing collection.
- At Santori Library, these limited services will be available through our drive-thru; at West Branch in our entryway and at Eola Road Branch in our Small Meeting Room.
- These services will be available from 10:00am to 6:00pm Monday-Friday, and 10:00am to 2:00pm Saturday, through April 5, 2020.
